Weekly update on the work of the Commission

Operational activity

As at 17 July 2024, the National Anti-Corruption Commission (the Commission):

- is conducting 28 preliminary investigations
- is conducting 27 corruption investigations, including 7 joint investigations
- is overseeing or monitoring 19 investigations by other agencies
- has 6 matters before the court
- has 431 referrals pending assessment.

Over the period from 1 July 2024 to midnight Sunday 14 July 2024, the Commission:

- received 77 referrals
- excluded 27 referrals at triage stage
- had one matter progress to court.

In last week's media alert, the number of referrals pending assessment was underreported due to an arithmetical error.
