## Weekly update on the work of the Commission

### Operational activity

As at 4 September 2024, the National Anti-Corruption Commission (the Commission):

- is conducting 33 preliminary investigations
- is conducting 29 corruption investigations, including 8 joint investigations
- is overseeing or monitoring 16 investigations by other agencies
- has 7 matters before the court
- has 468 referrals pending assessment.

Over the period from 1 July 2024 to midnight Sunday 1 September 2024, the Commission:

- received 414 referrals
- excluded 350 referrals at triage stage.
