Weekly update on the work of the Commission

Operational activity

As at 18 December 2024, the National Anti-Corruption Commission (the Commission):

- is conducting 39 preliminary investigations
- is conducting 28 corruption investigations, including 7 joint investigations
- is overseeing or monitoring 18 investigations by other agencies
- has 5 matters before the court
- has 559 referrals pending assessment.

Over the period from 1 July 2024 to midnight Sunday 15 December 2024, the Commission:

- received 1,176 referrals
- excluded 952 referrals at triage stage.
